Extension of the Special Unemployment Insurance

April 6th, 2020



The Ministry of Labor and Social Security issued on April 3, 2020 a new resolution related to the special unemployment subsidy regime created by Resolution No 143 dated March 18, 2020 and expanded by Resolution No 163 dated March 20, 2020.

Main aspects of the new resolution to be considered:

- 1- Extends the special unemployment subsidy regime until May 31, 2020.
- 2- As from April 1st., 2020, the articles number 2 and 3 of the Resolution No 143 will be amended as follows:
- I) Includes employees with a 6 minimum worked days in the month and a maximum of 19 days worked in the month, or the reduction in a 50% of the total hours of their regular schedule, provided that they meet the requirements of Decree Law No. 15.180 and amendments.
- II) The amount of the social benefit will be the equivalent to 25% of the monthly average of the gross remunerations, received in the previous six months.
- III) The remunerations to be considered includes those works or activities that generate the subsidy.
- IV) The amount to be received will not be less than 75% of the average of the monthly remunerations received in the last six months.
